Come visit the Moynihan Train Hall!

This 255,000-square-foot transportation hub designed by SOM in the heart of Midtown Manhattan and named after former U.S. Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan. This project transformed the former James A. Farley Building (U.S. Post Office) into a world-class facility and increased the existing Penn Station rail complex's concourse space by 50%. Led by Empire State Development (ESD), the \$1.6 billion project was accomplished through an innovative public-private partnership between ESD, Vornado Realty Trust, The Related Companies, Skanska, the MTA, the Long Island Rail Road, Amtrak, and the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey. It utilized a design-build approach to streamline construction and expedite completion.
